



ISRAEL IN FOCUS TOUR



Day 1 - Fri 23rd October

Depart New Zealand via Dubai

Today we will depart New Zealand on flights from Auckland or Christchurch to Dubai. On arrival, we will transfer to our connecting flight to Tel Aviv.

Day 2 - Sat 24th October

Arrival in Israel, Ancient Joppa

Upon landing at Ben Gurion International Airport in Israel, we will first retrieve our luggage and clear customs. Following this, we will meet our Israeli tour guide, board our Coach, and travel to the ancient city of Joppa. Joppa is renowned as the place associated with the prophet Jonah and where the Apostle Peter received the pivotal vision that commissioned him to spread the gospel message to the gentiles.



Day 3 - Sun 25th October

Tel Aviv, Ayalon Institute, Valley of Elah

We begin our day at the Yitzhak Rabin Center, a modern museum and archive complex dedicated to the life and political and military legacy of one of Israel's most critical leaders. This site offers deep insight into the complex history of the State of Israel through Rabin's personal journey. We will then travel south to the Ayalon Institute in Rehovot. This former clandestine bullet factory operated secretly during the British Mandate (1945-1948). The factory was vital in supplying the Hagana (the pre-state defence force) with ammunition for Israel's War. Finally we will go to the site David fought Goliath in the Valley of Elah to recount this biblical story.



Day 4 - Mon 26th October

October 7 Memorial Sites, ANZAC History, Tel Sheva



Our day will begin in the Gaza Envelope, a region touched by the tragic events of October 7th. We approach this time with reverence, seeking to honor the memory of the victims and stand in solidarity with the survivors and affected communities. We will meet with the Executive Director of Lifeshield, an organization dedicated to providing safety shelters and other resources for vulnerable communities in Israel. Following this morning of reflection, we will travel south to Beersheva, a city rich in history. This area holds echoes of the heroism from World War I, specifically the legendary charge of the Light Horsemen and the ANZACs campaign. After a visit to the ANZAC Museum, our final stop is the ancient ruins of Tel Sheva (Tel Be'er Sheva), a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Here, we can survey not only the location of the famous charge but also the ancient biblical history where figures like Abraham sojourned.

Day 5 - Tues 27th October

Masada, Ein Gedi & Dead Sea Experience

This morning we head straight to Masada, a UNESCO World Heritage site. This ancient fortress, atop an isolated rock plateau, symbolises the ancient Jewish kingdom's final resistance against the Romans. We will ascend via the cable car—for a spectacular view over the Dead Sea and Jordanian mountains. Our guide will transform this geological wonder into a profound historical experience, sharing gripping tales of King Herod's palace and the heroic siege. Next, we visit the En Gedi Nature Reserve, a stark contrast to the previous location. This lush oasis in the Judean Desert, famous as David's refuge from King Saul, features breathtaking natural beauty. We'll take a short hike to discover stunning waterfalls and pools fed by natural springs, perfect for photography and quiet reflection. Keep an eye out for local wildlife, including the rock hyraxes and the majestic Ibex. Our day concludes back at our Dead Sea resort, the lowest point on Earth renowned for its hyper-saline waters, which allow you to float effortlessly—a truly unique and relaxing experience.

DEAD SEA



Day 6 - Weds 28th October

Qumran, Allenby Bridge Crossing, Petra

We depart the Dead Sea travelling to the ancient site of Qumran, the likely settlement of the Essenes and the discovery location of the Dead Sea Scrolls. Later we will cross into Jordan via the Allenby/King Hussein Bridge. The drive will continue through Jordanian landscapes toward the ancient city of Petra. Arriving in the afternoon, the exploration of Petra begins by walking through the iconic Siq gorge, leading to the dramatic reveal of Al-Khazneh, "The Treasury," Petra's most famous carved facade. The day concludes with dinner at the hotel, with an optional special night tour of Petra available, where the Siq and Treasury are illuminated by candles.

JORDAN



Day 7 - Thur 29th October


Mount Nebo, Madaba, Amman

The full-day tour starts with an early departure from Petra to Amman, traveling through Jordan's historic, spiritual heartlands, including the ancient territory of Moab. The first key stop is Mount Nebo, a site of deep Old Testament reverence where, according to the Book of Deuteronomy, Moses saw the Promised Land (the Jordan Valley, the Dead Sea, and Jerusalem's hills) before his death after leading the Israelites for forty years. This region is also significant as the place where the Moabite woman Ruth journeyed from to Bethlehem, leading to her inclusion in the lineage of King David and ultimately Jesus, as recounted in the Book of Ruth. The location also features a Franciscan church and striking mosaics. The tour continues to Madaba, the "City of Mosaics," famous for its exceptional Byzantine and Umayyad mosaics. Crucially, the 6th-century Madaba Map on the floor of the Greek Orthodox Church of St. George is the oldest surviving cartographic depiction of the Holy Land and surrounding areas, including the Nile Delta and parts of Lebanon. This accurate map highlights numerous biblical sites, offering an invaluable geographical link to the Bible's narratives, making Madaba a compelling stop before the journey ends in Amman.

Day 8 - Frid 30th October

Sheik Hussein Crossing, Beit Shean, Galilee

Returning to Israel around mid-morning after driving north to the Sheik Hussein Border Crossing (also known as the Jordan River Crossing), our journey will include a refreshing stop for lunch near the ancient city of Beit Shean. Beit Shean was a prominent city of the Decapolis, and the location where the bodies of King Saul and his son Jonathan were hung on the walls. It is also one of the cities (Scythopolis) mentioned in the Gospels where Jesus' ministry extended. Following our visit to the impressive archaeological ruins of this former Roman city, we will continue north toward the much-anticipated region of Galilee. This area holds profound biblical importance as the heartland where Jesus and His disciples lived, worked, and ministered, and where many of the miracles and key teachings of the New Testament took place. We anticipate arriving at our accommodation situated by the beautiful Sea of Galilee in good time for dinner and a well-deserved rest.



Day 9 - Sat 31st October

GALILEE



Galilee Boat Ride, Tabgha, Capernaum, Magdala, Mt Arbel

Our day begins with a serene boat ride on the Sea of Galilee (also known as Lake Kinneret or Lake Tiberias), the setting for many of Jesus's miracles, including calming the storm and walking on water (Mark 4:35-41; Matthew 14:22-33). Following the peaceful voyage, we will visit the Yigal Allon Center to see the "Jesus Boat," a remarkably preserved ancient fishing vessel discovered in the mud of the Galilee, offering a tangible link to the time when Jesus's disciples worked these waters. Next, we journey to Tabgha, traditionally recognised as the location of the multiplication of the loaves and fish (Mark 6:30-44) and possibly the third post-resurrection appearance of Jesus (John 21:1-19). Just a short drive away lies Capernaum, often called "Jesus's own town" (Matthew 9:1), where he lived, taught in the synagogue, and performed numerous healings, including that of the centurion's servant and Peter's mother-in-law (Matthew 8:5-17). We then head south to Magdala, the likely hometown of Mary Magdalene, a devoted follower of Jesus, and the site of a recently excavated first-century synagogue where Jesus may have preached. The day culminates with a drive up to Mount Arbel, providing breathtaking panoramic views of the entire region, including the Sea of Galilee, a vantage point that allows reflection on the vast area where Jesus conducted his ministry.

Day 10 - Sun 1st November

Golan Heights, Caesarea Philippi, Temple Dan

Our day takes us north via the beautiful Hula Valley to Mount Bental, an ancient volcano offering a panoramic vista of the Golan Heights and into Syria. We then descend for lunch enroute to Caesarea Philippi (Banias), where Jesus asked the pivotal question, "Who do people say that the Son of Man is?" (Matthew 16:13-20). This site was once a center of pagan worship. Our final stop is Tel Dan, the northernmost boundary of ancient Israel, famously known from "from Dan to Beersheba" (Judges 20:1), where we see the remains of a biblical city and Jeroboam I's High Place (1 Kings 12:28-30).



Day 11 - Mon 2nd November

MEGIDDO



Nazareth Village, Tel Megiddo, Caesarea Maritime

The day starts with our departure from Galilee, and continuing our journey through biblical history...and prophecy. The first stop is Nazareth Village, a first-century reconstruction providing context for Jesus's early life (Luke 2:40, Matthew 2:23). Next is Tel Megiddo, the ancient city overlooking the Jezreel Valley. It's identified with Armageddon (Revelation 16:16) and is historically significant as a key fortress under King Solomon (1 Kings 9:15).


Continuing west, we visit Caesarea Maritima, the major port city built by Herod the Great. It is immensely significant as the location of the conversion of the Roman centurion Cornelius (Acts 10:1-48) and where Paul was imprisoned and defended himself (Acts 23:23-26:32). As the afternoon wanes, the much-anticipated bus journey begins, ascending through the Judean hills toward our final destination: Jerusalem. This eternal city is the most crucial site in biblical history, serving as the Jewish political and religious centre and the location of Christ's crucifixion and resurrection.

Day 12 - Tues 3rd November

City of David, Hezekiah's Tunnel, Israel Museum


Our day begins after breakfast in the City of David with a 3D movie, followed by a walk through Hezekiah's Tunnel, the new Pilgrims Road, and the Pool of Siloam. The City of David is where King David established his capital and brought the Ark of the Covenant (2 Samuel 5:6-10, 6:12). King Hezekiah constructed the tunnel to secure Jerusalem's water supply during the Assyrian siege (2 Kings 20:20, 2 Chronicles 32:30). The Pool of Siloam is famous as the site where Jesus healed the man born blind (John 9:1-7). We will enjoy a longer lunch today at the vibrant Mahaneh Yehudah markets, offering Middle Eastern delights and souvenir shopping. Later, we explore the Israel Museum, including the Jerusalem Model and the Shrine of the Book, which houses the Dead Sea Scrolls—crucial evidence for the Old Testament text. We'll visit the Knesset Menorah and conclude the day with a hotel visit from a local Messianic Pastor. Dinner and overnight are at our Jerusalem hotel.

JERUSALEM



Day 13 - Weds 4th November

Garden Tomb, Yad Vashem, Shiloh, Shepherds Fields



Our day begins with a visit to the Garden Tomb, a traditional place of Jesus' crucifixion and resurrection, offering a meaningful opportunity to reflect on the events described in the Gospels (e.g., John 19:41-42, 20:1-18). Following this, we drive to Yad Vashem, Israel's official Holocaust memorial, for a moving experience commemorating the victims of the Holocaust. After lunch, we journey to Ancient Shiloh, a site of profound biblical significance as the central place of worship and the location of the Tabernacle for the Israelites before the building of the First Temple in Jerusalem (Joshua 18:1; 1 Samuel 1:3). We conclude our day in Bethlehem, visiting the Shepherds' Fields, traditionally identified as the place where the angels announced Jesus' birth to the shepherds (Luke 2:8-20), including a special visit to one of the ancient caves before returning to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

Day 14 - Thurs 5th November


Temple Mount, Jewish Qtr, Western Wall, Tunnels

This morning, we visit the Temple Mount, the historically and biblically significant site of the First and Second Jewish Temples (central to Jesus' ministry, e.g., Matthew 21:12-13), followed by the Wohl Archaeological Museum, showcasing Second Temple artifacts. We continue through the Old Jewish Quarter, seeing the Byzantine Cardo and King Hezekiah's Broad Wall. After lunch, we visit the Western Wall (Kotel) and explore the Western Wall Tunnels showcasing Jerusalem's history. Later, we visit the Southern Steps where pilgrims ascended and Jesus taught (e.g., Mark 14:49). Here, we discuss the destruction of the Temple, as Jesus prophesied in Matthew 24:1-2: "Truly I tell you, not one stone here will be left on another; every one will be thrown down." Returning for dinner, the optional evening activity is the special Tower of David Light and Sound Show. Dinner and overnight at our Jerusalem hotel.



Day 15 - Frid 6th November

Via Dolorosa, Gethsemene, Mount of Olives



Our final day of touring focuses on the solemn path of Jesus leading to His crucifixion, a central event in Christian theology (John 19:16-18). We commence by walking the Via Dolorosa, the traditional route of Christ's suffering, which has historical roots dating back to the Byzantine era. Our journey includes visits to St. Anne's Church, a beautiful example of Crusader architecture and traditionally the birthplace of the Virgin Mary, and the nearby Pools of Bethesda (John 5:1-9), a historically significant site where Jesus miraculously healed a paralytic. The culmination of this morning's spiritual focus is the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, the widely accepted and historically venerated site of both Christ's crucifixion (Golgotha) and resurrection. Following lunch in the historic Christian Quarter, we proceed to the tranquil Garden of Gethsemane (Matthew 26:36-46), a place of immense biblical significance where Jesus prayed intensely before His arrest. From there, we will trace the Palm Sunday Road, commemorating Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem (Matthew 21:1-11). We then conclude our day on the Mount of Olives (Luke 19:29-44), which offers a spectacular panoramic view over the ancient city and is prophesied as the location for Christ's return (Zechariah 14:4). Dinner and overnight accommodation will be at our Jerusalem hotel.

Day 16 - Sat 7th November

Departure Day

Our final day in Israel offers a more relaxed pace, providing an opportunity to pack for our return journey to Australia or onwards to other destinations. Whether you choose a quiet coffee, a reflective Shabbat stroll, grabbing last-minute souvenirs, or visiting a nearby site, you will have time to reflect on the past 15 days and rejoice in the profound experiences you've had in the land of the Bible. The bus will then transfer us to Ben Gurion Airport, stopping for lunch en route for some final fellowship before we bid farewell, leaving with lifelong memories and faith building knowledge to keep, and share with others.

Day 1 Saturday 7th November


Athens

We will travel to Athens as a group from Israel where we will be greeted by our Tour providers for the time in Greece. We will be transported to our hotel for some rest before we begin our exciting tour the next day.

Day 2 Sunday 8th November

Athens

This morning, visit the famous Acropolis to see the Propylae, the Erechtheum and the Parthenon. From there we will get a clear view of the city of Athens, as well as the Ancient Agora (ancient marketplace where Paul spoke to the ancient Athenians). Ascending the hill, we will pass through the Mars Hill, where Paul preached to the ancient Athenians. Our visit is not complete without a tour of the New Acropolis Museum, which houses the findings of the Acropolis of Athens. Then we continue with a bus tour of the city where we will see the House of Parliament, the tomb of the Unknown Soldier, Hadrian's Arch and the Panathenaic Stadium. Afternoon at leisure to explore the city further.




Day 3 Monday 9th November

Cruise, Mykonos

After breakfast we will be transferred to the port of Lavrio where we will board our cruise. We will set sail around noon cruising to the beautiful Greek Island of Mykonos. Here there is an opportunity to take a stroll along the narrow-cobbled streets, past chic boutiques, white-washed churches and elegant cafes and restaurants should you choose to opt for dinner on shore. Shuttle buses operate continuously between the port and Mykonos town. Overnight on board. (B, L, D)





ANCIENT EPHESUS

Day 4 Tuesday 10th November

Cruise, Kusadasi, Patmos

This morning, we arrive in Kusadasi where we join an excursion to Ancient Ephesus (KUS-02).

Morning visit to Ephesus in Kusadasi. At Ancient Ephesus we find Immortal relics of the Hellenistic, Roman and Early Christian era. At the archaeological site we will be given a guided tour among the Agora, the Odeon, the Library of Celsus, the marble-paved main Street of Kouretes, the Baths of Scholastica, Trajan's Fountain, the Public Latrines, the Residences of the Patricians, the Prytaneum, the Temple of Hadrian...The Great Theatre, built in the 4th century B.C., could accommodate 24,000 spectators and it is famous even nowadays for its acoustics. The finds from the excavations, which have yet brought to light only 13% of ancient Ephesus, reside in the Archaeological Museum of Ephesus, in the city of Selcuk. During the excursion we will have a chance to do some shopping and see the carpet waving demonstration.



PATMOS

Day 4 Tuesday 10th November

Cruise, Kusadasi, Patmos

In the afternoon, the included excursion is to the Greek Orthodox St. John monastery and Cave of Apocalypse in Patmos (PAT-oi). The picturesque alleyways wind upwards, towards the Monastery of St. John the Evangelist, founded in 1088 by St. Christodoulos. The visit will open the doors for us to the Monastery's yard, the place where the monks take their meals and the old bakery. Of exquisite beauty is the tour of the Byzantine Church of St. John, which is adorned with a wood-carved icon screen, important frescoes from several periods, with both mosaic and other icons. Our next stop is the small museum which hosts religious treasures of inestimable value, like manuscripts, medieval textiles and sacerdotal vestments. Behind the chapel of St. Anne lies the entrance to the Grotto of the Apocalypse. There we will see numerous things of interest steeped in orthodox tradition, such as the triple fissure in the wall of the cave, from where it is said John heard God dictating to him the Apocalypse and the spot where he lay down to sleep. Overnight on board. (B, L,D)



RHODES

Day 5 Wednesday 11th November

Cruise, Rhodes

Upon arrival in Rhodos, we join the excursion to Acropolis of Lindos and the Citadel of the Knights (RHO 01)

Arriving at Rhodes in the morning, we first travel to Lindos. It is here where the Apostle Paul first set foot on the island in the year 52 AD. Lindos is about 55km from Rhodes Town and high above the village sits the impressive Acropolis with the Doric Temple of Athena, built in 300 BC. Captains' mansions constructed between the 16th and 18th centuries are dotted here and there and in the heart of Lindos is the Church of the Virgin Mary with lovely frescoes from the 15th Century. Back in Rhodes is where we are really immersed in the history of the island in the Knights' Quarter. We stroll through Gate d'Amboise to walk along the Street of the Knights and see where they lived, separated according to Order, their crests still visible today. We will also see (outside) the imposing Palace of the Grand Master of the Knights of Rhodes, a medieval castle also known as the Kastello. It's one of the few examples of Gothic architecture in Greece. The Byzantine citadel was built in the 7th Century, the palace itself in the fourteenth. Where the palace sits today could well have been the spot where the Colossus once stood, according to recent studies. We return to the ship and sail off into the sunset for another night at Sea. (B, L, D)



SANTORINI

Day 6 Thursday 12th November

Cruise, Santorini

This morning, we arrive in Santorini where we join the excursion to Oia (SAN-oi)

If you are a first time visitor to Santorini she will take your breath away. And even if you are a regular visitor, with her soaring landscapes and whitewashed houses she will still do that every time. She is regularly described as one of the most beautiful places on the planet. There are plenty of magic moments on our excursion.

One of the greatest spectacles is Oia village perched on the rim of the Caldera, the remains of a volcanic eruption. Santorini is a ring of rock around the sea. Think of it as the rim of an old volcano.

First, we head to Megalochori, one of the most authentic and unspoiled villages on the island, retaining its distinctive architecture, character and charm.

Our trip continues eastwards through a number of traditional communities like Firostefani and Imerovigli until we arrive at Oia. On our journey we will have had the lace-like caldera to our west, the little islands of Thirasia, Palea and Nea Kameni and an incredible, unsurpassable panoramic view.

There is plenty of time in Oia to explore, stroll the marble-paved alleys, visit the adorable shops and capture the moments on camera. Admire the traditional buildings carved into the rocks and the unusual captain's manors, the settlement. Depart Santorini this evening, sailing overnight to Athens. (B, L,D)



CORINTH

Day 7 Friday 13th November

Ancient Corinth, Depart Athens

Following your disembarkation in the morning, we drive to the Corinth Canal, which separates Peloponnese from the Greek mainland and connects the two Seas, the Ionian, and the Aegean. Continue to Ancient Corinth, one of the most important trading cities of ancient Greece dating back to the 6th century B.C.

Here under the shadow of the towering Acropolis, the Apostle Paul preached and lived for two years. The vigorous and mostly Gentile Church he founded here in 50 AD caused him much grief and prompted him to write at least four letters. Visit the ruins of the ancient city where Paul worked with Aquila and Priscilla. See the remains of first century shops, the agora where Paul's trial by Gallio took place, the Fountain of Peirene, Temple of Apollo and the Bema.

Our tour concludes with our transfer to the airport in Athens and check-in for our flight back to New Zealand. We depart with incredible memories and life long friendships.

PLEASE READ THESE TERMS CAREFULLY. ENROLMENT AND PAYMENT OF A DEPOSIT FOR THE TOUR CONSTITUTES ACCEPTANCE OF THESE TERMS. Upon payment of the Deposit, the Registration Form forms part of the Terms and the agreement between the passengers and Olive Tree Travel.

MINIMUM NUMBERS:

- Your booking and the tour are not confirmed until Olive Tree Travel provides written confirmation that the minimum number requirements have been met. The Price of the main tour will be based on minimum number requirements of paying passengers (as set out on the Tour Flyer) for the relevant tour (unless Olive Tree Travel advises otherwise in writing), air and hotel rates and currency exchange rate effective at the time of final invoicing by Olive tree Travel. If any changes downwards of more than 3%, the price may change accordingly. If minimum numbers are not met, and we cancel (or not proceed with) your booking, we will refund the deposit paid. Olive Tree Travel is not responsible for expenses incurred by passengers for other travel arrangements affected by a cancellation.

CONFIRMATION OF BOOKING:

Please note: Tickets and documentation will be despatched approximately 2-3 weeks prior to your group's departure.

GROUP PACKAGE PRICE:

- **HOTELS:** All hotels offer twin or double bedded rooms with private facilities. Single or 3 bedded room, if requested, are at an additional cost. The cost of the ground arrangements as offered is based upon each busload of passengers pursuant to the minimum number of passengers required set out in the Tour Flyer. JURISDICTION

Notwithstanding this clause, Olive Tree Travel relies on and receives the benefits of international conventions, national and international law in respect to air travel and transportation which may apply to the services provided by service providers and Olive Tree Travel.

DEFINITIONS

Force Majeure Event means any event beyond Olive Tree Travel or Olive Tree Travel suppliers' control, the consequence of which could not have been avoided even if all reasonable measures have been taken. This includes, but is not limited to, warfare and acts of terrorism (and threat thereof), civil strife, significant risk to human health such as the outbreak of serious or infectious disease, epidemic, pandemic or natural disaster such as floods, earthquakes or weather conditions which makes it impossible to travel safely to the travel destination or remain at the travel destination, the act of any government or other national or local authority including port or river authorities, industrial disputes, labour strikes, blocks, closures, nuclear disasters, fire, chemical or biological disasters, unavoidable technical problems with transport or a change in the law.
